

THE HISTORY OF MY FRIEND ZEUS.

He is a pure bred west Highland White Terrier “Westie”, born April 1, 2001

May 5, 2004 - actual roadside rescue from abusive owner – the third owner in three years.

- ❖ Condition – Coat patchy, approximately 10% missing.
- ❖ Skin – pink to red
- ❖ Eyes – rheumy with pin stains at corners.
- ❖ Weight – 13.5 lbs.
- ❖ Vomit almost immediately after eating .

Health history and diet unknown.

Veterinary History – 6 different vets some requiring 50 plus miles travel based on their purported specialty. Diagnosis –

- ❖ mega esophagus- totally unfounded
- ❖ hyperactive –introduce medication (possibly medicate their children accordingly).
- ❖ acid reflux – possibly?
- ❖ somewhat typical Westie issues unfortunately consolidated in this one dog.
- ❖ Allergies – unknown, could be anything (you think).

Veterinary dietary recommendations –

- ❖ try different kibble.
- ❖ try canned food (no suggestions since they are “all generally the same” - except the brand we (vet) carry.
- ❖ THE FAMOUS RAW DIET - because “ dogs are carnivores” per this vet who coincidentally had a business relationship with a local unlicensed provider and the most unscientifically supported recommendation.
